Construction update



Spring has brought brighter days and a spirit of growth at Manor Lakes. Crews have been working around the clock to complete a range of amenities in time for the end-of-year holidays, including a new park and updates to the Display Village.

		park and updates to the Display Village.
1	Manor Lakes Boulevard Park	The Manor Lakes Boulevard Park is now open beside the Manor Lakes Sales Office. The park offers a large playground, sporting amenities, public toilets, shaded BBQ areas with family seating, and a purpose-built fenced dog park.
2	Landscaping	Crews have continued landscaping works in the Village Wetlands, adding a welcome touch to the neighbourhood. The project includes extensive planting, perimeter walking paths, and a boardwalk. The Village Wetlands will open in April 2025.
3	Stage 202 and Stage 203 Update	In Stage 202, crews have completed electrical and telecommunications work and will lay the final layer of asphalt, along with finishing lot grading and topsoiling over the next week, with an expected completion date of January 2025.
		In Stage 203, crews are wrapping up electrical and telecommunications work. They will follow this with the final layer of asphalt and lot grading in early December, aiming for completion in March 2025.
4	Display Village	The new Display Village has opened beside Manor Lakes Boulevard Park. You can now explore eight display homes from Carlisle Homes, Mimosa Homes, and Central Property. The remaining

Community fund boosts swimming skills

Manager of Kingswim Manor Lakes, Bennjamin Bevis, said the classes were well received. "We had a few different backgrounds there, English was very limited, but our general consensus was that both children and parents enjoyed the program."

Participants aged between 6 and 12 from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds were nominated by the Wyndham Cultural and Education centre. The intensive program teaches water safety and improves the swimming confidence of participants, regardless of their swimming ability.

Kingswim is a leading swim school with a mission to teach water safety and swimming skills to people of all ages. Their Manor Lakes centre offers a variety of programs, including baby swimming classes, kids' learn-to-swim, and adult lessons, all delivered by qualified instructors.

The intensive program is available to new and enrolled students—"The goal for those already enrolled is to improve their skills," Bennjamin said. "For new students, it gives them an experience with the goal of hopefully enrolling them on going into our ongoing programme."

Kingswim was one of 20 local community groups to receive the \$1500 grant in 2023.

1 Earth Toned Naturals

The Earth Toned Naturals trend draws inspiration from raw and handcrafted materials.

Key colours for this trend include rust, terracotta, and pops of mustard and apricot pink. These hues sit perfectly alongside finishes of warm-toned wood, textured fabrics in earthy colours, and natural stone.

Introduce earth tones into your interiors with paint colours of off-white or light taupe. Ensure there are elements of natural timber and timber laminates in your joinery. Add freestanding furnishings and small décor items to your rooms for a less permanent option.

2 Nothing but Neutral


The Nothing but Neutral trend primarily focuses on built-in and freestanding furnishings in your home, elevating them to luxury long-term investment pieces.

3 Playful Minimalism

Moving away from traditional palettes, the Playful Minimalism trend leans towards clean lines, curved edges, and whimsy.

The Playful Minimalism palette is perfect for a master suite, where a calming neutral base can add to the relaxation.

The base of this trend is minimal with clean lines and neutral tones. Layer in playful colours and elements through bed linen, bathroom towels, and cushion covers.

4 Classic Chrome

The polished chrome finish is back in a new modern way. Resurfacing with glamour, the Classic Chrome trend influences freestanding furnishings, like chairs, lighting, and accessories. Chrome surfaces act as mirrored finishes that enhance light and make spaces feel larger.

Soften the appearance of chrome with textured surfaces, like plush rugs and sherpa fabric chairs. Pairing modern chrome against natural walnut woods also creates a colour and texture contrast.

Method

Preheat oven to 218°C. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

Cut broccoli into florets.

Add the broccoli to a baking sheet. Spray or drizzle on olive oil and season with salt, pepper, and garlic powder.

Roast for 25 minutes. Once cooked, remove and keep warm

Croutons

Pre-heat oven to 180 C. Toast bread in the oven for 2 minutes each side.

Remove from the oven and rub with garlic. Brush with olive oil and sprinkle with salt.

Bake until golden brown, turning halfway through. Monitor your bread to ensure it doesn't burn. Cooking times will vary depending on which bread you use.

Salad

Cook bacon in a frypan until golden brown on both sides.

Remove from frypan and place on paper towels until cool. Chop into small pieces and set aside. Cut chicken breasts in half, horizontally and cut into bite-sized pieces.

Season with salt, pepper, and garlic powder to taste.

Fry in the same skillet/pan as you fried the bacon until cooked through.

Dressing

Blend the garlic, anchovy paste, lemon juice, mustard and Worcestershire sauce.

Combine the mixture with the mayonnaise, and parmesan. Stir until combined.

Season to your liking before mixing once again. Set aside.

Assemble the salad

Combine the broccoli, chicken, bacon, and croutons in a bowl.

Drizzle with creamy Caesar dressing and garnish with parmesan cheese to taste. Enjoy!

Ingredients

Salad

150g streaky bacon

500g chicken breast fillets

1 large head of broccoli

1 tbsp olive oil

Dressing

2 small garlic cloves, minced or 1 tsp garlic powder

1 tsp anchovy paste

2 tbsp lemon juice

1 tsp Dijon mustard

1 tsp Worcestershire sauce

1 cup mayonnaise

1/2 cup grated parmesan

1/4 tsp salt

1/4 tsp black pepper

Homemade croutons


3 slices thick white bread

1 garlic bulb

1 tbsp olive oil

1/4 tsp salt
